**“Sing The Book of Psalms”**

Dear **Yeshua**,

The following is derived from audio notes I recorded.

**Sunday, 10 January 2021, 8:00AM.**

This is part three of the dream series of Singing the Psalms.

Yesterday I received an email from (CB42) issuing a Letter of Apology about his (*failed*) prophetic word concerning the re-election of President Trump. I have neither seen nor heard the video or audio versions yet, only the email.

Generally speaking, (please understand I'm "painting with a broad brush" here), it seems like most of the prophets, including (CB42), who prophesied Trump winning a second term, come from what I would call the Pentecostal and/or Charismatic Churches. The Pentecostal/Charismatic Church is where I grew up, in my younger years as a young child, and into my teens. So I know how they think.

Spiritually speaking, the Pentecostal Church is my mother. It was at a Pentecostal youth camp where I was born again. She is my Spiritual Mom, so be careful if you want to say bad things about her, on account of I might get irate. Even though I disagree with her in some areas, she's still my Mom, so leave her alone.

The one thing I've observed is that there is an infection within the Prophetic Voice of the Pentecostal Church. It has to do with prophetic grandstanding, and a large amount of pride, along with manipulation and control, which has been part of that prophetic voice since I can remember. In Letter 67 Volume 2 the Lord Holy Spirit gave me a dream which speaks to this very issue. He also gave me a prayer for the healing of the Pentecostal church. I'm going to suggest the possibility that the Lord is using this election cycle to, among other things, help clean up the prophetic voice of the Pentecostal Churches. What I have observed over the years is that many of these prophets will qualify their messages with the phrase "thus saith the Lord", or other words with the same meaning, thereby suggesting that if their words or not adhered to, it would be tantamount to disobeying God. This puts that prophet in a position of power over the people, thereby making that prophet a "Nicolaitan", whose deeds and doctrines Christ our Lord hates. See Revelation 2:6, 15.

Rather than prophesy in such an assertive tone, it would be better if they would take a more gentle approach, prefacing their words with something like "*this is what I believe I am hearing the Lord say,*" or, "*this is what the Lord is saying to me.*"

In fact, for a prophet to say a word to the entire church, and assert that it applies to everyone, violates the privacy policy Jesus established in this Scripture:

**The Book of John**

**Chapter 21**

**Verses 21 and 22**

Peter, seeing him, said to Jesus,  
“But Lord, what about this man?”

Jesus said to him,  
“If I will that he remain till I come,  
what is that to you?

**You follow Me.”**

So, it may very well be that the Lord Jesus is going to use this election cycle to clean up the prophetic voice in the Pentecostal church. I'll see what happens day by day, and wait to hear how the Lord explains it to me. As I wrote in the previous Letter, these things get explained to me to whatever detail is needed, so I'm never without understanding about these matters. If I seem to be short of understanding, all I have to do is ask.

Thank you Jesus, and may God bless everyone who hears this report.
