Four days ago a very large ocean-going container vessel got wedged sideways in the Suez Canal. Even as I write this Letter, the boat is still “stuck in the mud”, while a variety of governments and business organizations are at present jointly working together, attempting to dislodge the ship and free up the waterway for a resumption of normal shipping traffic.

*Ever Given is a Golden-class container ship, one of the largest container ships in the world. On 23 March 2021, while traveling from Tanjung Pelepas, Malaysia to Rotterdam, Netherlands, the ship ran aground in the Suez Canal, blocking it.*

*The ship is owned by Shoeni Kisen Kaisha (a ship owning and leasing subsidiary of the large Japanese shipbuilding company Imabari Shipbuilding), and time chartered and operated by Taiwanese container transportation and shipping company Evergreen Marine. Ever Given is registered in Panama, and its technical management is the responsibility of the German ship management company Bernhard Schulte Ship management.*
