**The Word Against The Reprobate Mind**

Dear Dan,

Over the years I have considered many things regarding the Reprobate Mind, and especially since the time I saw the news report about the Westboro Church's protest against it. At the same time, somewhere along the Way, the Lord highlighted to me a few Scriptures that reveal His heart towards homosexuals in general, and in these last days in particular.

This is one of those things where one actually has to actively look for the Word ("seek and you shall find"), and then walk in that Word for it to be effective. So a few years ago I observed that there is indeed a weapon that will bring liberty to those caught in the prison of reprobation. Jesus identified that weapon when he commented on the spiritual condition of certain cities, comparing them with Sodom:

*"And thou, Capernaum, which art exalted unto heaven, shalt be brought down to hell: for if  
 >>> **the mighty works** <<<,  
 which have been done in thee,  
**had been done in Sodom, it would have remained until this day**".  
**Matthew 11:23***

That weapon was given to the Church as part of the "non-carnal" arsenal which is a result of the Gift of the Holy Spirit. Paul further identifies how that weapon is to operate in his first letter to the Corinthians, describing functional gifts that are SUPPOSED to be at work in the Church.

*"Now ye are the body of Christ, and members in particular. And God hath set some in the church, first apostles, secondarily prophets, thirdly teachers, **after that miracles**, then gifts of healings, helps, governments, diversities of tongues.*

*Are all apostles? are all prophets? are all teachers?*

*>>> **are all workers of miracles?**<<<*

*Have all the gifts of healing? do all speak with tongues? do all interpret? But covet earnestly the best gifts: and yet shew I unto you a more excellent way.  
 1 Corinthians 12:27-31 (KJV)*

The weapon's power is multiplied in that it is comprised of

**"MIGHTY WORKS"**

I grew up knowing about only three or four Biblical titles or offices in the Church. Pastor, Teacher, and Deacon. And then there were the Missionaries. But I was never taught about anything else. It wasn't until much later that the Lord begin teaching me in His Scriptures about all the missing components of; or unauthorized added components in; His Body on earth.

Has anyone been to a Church in their lifetime that has an office door with the title "Worker Of Miracles" over the door frame? How about "Prophet", or "Apostle"? But there are lots and lots of "Senior Pastors". That title is referred to in Scripture as "Chief Shepherd" and belongs to Christ alone.

Why was I never taught in Sunday School how to drive away demons? Yet Jesus made that first on the list of basic Christian functions in the world.

*"And these signs shall follow **them that believe**;*

*In my name shall they*

*1>>> cast out devils; they shall*

*2>>> speak with new tongues; They shall*

*3>>> take up serpents; and*

*4>>> if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall*

*5>>> lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover".*

**Mark 16:17-18**

The Word then against the Reprobate Mind is exactly what Jesus said both in the Scripture, and in the postscript of the last letter (#166).

When the Church gets its "Act" together, then the MIGHTY WORKS (of those things that are GREATER, STRONGER, SHARPER) will "emerge" and bring salvation to those who are caught up by the Reprobate Mind, and deliverance to those in the U.S. Government who promote and agree with it.

The "Act" that the Church in America needs to get together is in obeying fully every Word that proceeded out of the mouth of God the Son, both from Him and through His Apostles, as recorded in Scripture. First in Church structure. Second in Church operation.

It's that simple.
