Dear Dan,

On 3 January of this year my wife's sister (P9) sent me an email informing me of her desire to put together a surprise birthday party for (M). As stated in an earlier letter, (P9) and her family are Mormons, and have been for many years, although (P9), like her sister (M), was raised in a Methodist church.

In her next response to mine, the plan for the surprise party began to take shape. But then (P9) said something in the last paragraph of the email that opened the door for me to wrestle with Moroni.

But this first requires some backstory. About a year ago, I began to hear from my wife (M) how (P9a), her brother-in-law, was going down to Mexico and performing what amounted to Physical Therapy treatments for people he knew that had pulled muscles, etc.

I would hear bits & pieces of conversations concerning his treatment services by being in the family room at the same time that (M) and (P9) would talk on the phone, which they do daily. So, over the past year I would hear various remarks made concerning (P9a)'s activities, and how he was "gifted" in the area of understanding how the human body works, and how to bring relief to pinched nerve pains, etc.

Not long before (P9) sent the first email, (M) and I were discussing (P9a)'s activities. I said that I thought he was being reckless in essentially practicing medicine without a license, and of course not having any kind of insurance in the event he substantially injured someone he was working on. I avoided any mention that I thought (actually knew) that (P9a)'s activities were of Moroni (who's god is Satan), and that (P9a) was being deceived, and that he was deceiving those who partook of his services.

Below is the actual email exchange I had with (P9), edited in such a way so that the exchanges are in "topdown" chronological order. Identifying data has also been altered.

He will do it for no charge. If he can't do anything, he will tell you but I have never seen him hurt anyone and it could be a very helpful thing for you.
