**Sweet Hitchhiker(s)**

Dear Dan,

When I was in my twenties, both before and after the time that I hitchhiked down to California, I decided that one way I could obey the Lord in His instruction to be kind to others was to pick up hitchhikers whenever I could. So that's what I did for a long time.

After I married I quit picking up hitchhikers, focusing my ministerial efforts toward my wife and home. But after the motorcycle wreck, when I started driving, I begin to pick up hitchhikers again and continued to do so through and after the Day of 7.

I remember one hitchhiker I picked up, in the summer of 2000, wanted to go from (L12) to (G12) just outside of (L11). I let him in since I was going that way. We begin to talk and he let me know that he was going to meet up with some other people that were going to the Rainbow Gathering.

Then he said something interesting, in a lower tone as if an afterthought. He said the Rainbow People were

“... TRYING TO GET AWAY FROM BABYLON”.

That phrase got my attention since in the days prior to this, angel Gabe had been explaining to me about who he was and his Word against Babylon documented in the Book of Revelation (see Revelation chapter 18).

So when the hitchhiker said those words I figured it was pretty likely that the guy actually WAS angel Gabe “in the flesh”. (It was either that or Gabe was in the truck prophesying through the hitchhiker.)

Another time I was heading into town from home and picked up a guy going the same way. I was playing a CD, and we started talking over the music. As I was speaking, I briefly stuttered on one syllable of a word I was saying. At the very same time, the song being played on the CD stuttered too. I knew then that the guy really was Gabe, because just a few days before he had been causing me to stutter at certain times when I was trying to say something, and then said that it was a sign.

Then another time within days of this event I stopped to pick up a hitchhiking couple, a man and woman. After I said I was going into town the man said something like “OK Batman” as they both jumped into the bed of the truck.

I pretty much figured that I had picked up both Gabe and Gabriella, since just days before the topic of our discussions had been Batman and the most recent Batman movie that had just come to the theaters.\*

There were a couple more times that I can remember where I picked up a hitchhiker that I thought was Gabe, but these give you a pretty good idea of how it happened.
