The Three Fears Deliverance

Dear Dan,

It has been almost a month since the events that precipitated Letter 193 - The Word Against (G6). Last night, Friday, was the first time I had seen the mentioned co-worker (CS6) since that time, and there did seem to be a positive difference in her demeanor. But it is what was said while she was being delivered a month ago that is telling.
