Family Deliverance

Over the last day, subsequent to the events described in Letters 200 and 201, the Lord began to share His thoughts with me about these matters.

He led me to start to think in a different mode concerning (CB7) and his deliverance. Essentially, I was led to lay aside our earthly family ties in order to realize the superiority of our Kingdom relationship.

A new perspective was given to me from this standpoint;

(CB7) and I are both Believers in Christ and members of His Body, and our relationship is founded upon that truth.

The sorrow of the past therefore becomes powerless.

This makes any deliverance ministry the Lord may choose to pursue through my associates and me in (CB7)'s life much easier to accomplish, since the pain of the past is diminished.

In other terms, I have been led to think objectively from a Kingdom foundation of Joy and AVTOS, rather than subjectively from a temporal place of pain and sorrow.

The pain and sorrow were brought about by sin but not sin themselves, but rather a joining in Christ in His compassion for my brother and my family. Yet there comes a time for sackcloth and ashes to be removed, the body to be washed, and the Armor of Light to be assembled and put on.

Now is the time to set aside grieving over the sins of the past, and to put on the mantle of the Joy Of Battle (JOB) in overcoming and destroying the works of the Devil (part of the ministry of angels Luke and Mark).

For it is written:

*Brethren, I do not count myself to have apprehended; but one thing I do,
 forgetting those things which are behind and
 reaching forward to those things which are ahead,
 I press toward the goal for the prize of
 the upward call of God in Christ Jesus.*

Therefore let us, as many as are mature, have this mind; and

*if in anything you think otherwise, God will reveal even this to you.
Nevertheless, to the degree that we have already attained,
let us walk by the same rule,
let us be of the same mind.*

*Brethren, join in following my example, and note those who so walk,
as you have us for a pattern. For many walk, of whom I have told you often, and
now tell you even weeping, that they are the enemies of the cross of Christ:
whose end is destruction, whose god is their belly,
and whose glory is in their shame—
who set their mind on earthly things.*

For our citizenship is in heaven,

*from which we also eagerly wait for the Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ,
who will transform our lowly body that it may be conformed to His glorious body,
according to the working by which He is able even to subdue all things to Himself.
