**I Considered His Word,
And Became Sore Afraid.**

Dear Dan,

When I was seated at my desk preparing to write Letter 214, I paused for a moment to reflect on something I had previously thought about.

I had been thinking about the profundity of this phrase found in Scripture;

“THUS SAITH THE LORD”.

And I had been thinking about the various words against evil I had written throughout this year. But all those were either comprised of truths derived from Scripture, or Scripture itself. So I was not really saying anything new. Only making various points as led by the Holy Spirit.

But I knew that what we were being given now was unique. I did not know anything more than that. Just that the Lord wanted to say something about the Devil.

Before this I had been thinking about the phrase “thus saith the Lord”, or words that had the same meaning, and that they were to be used exclusively in Scripture, which to my mind is a closed book, a completed writing. And I wondered how in God’s Name could I possibly write anything even remotely resembling “thus saith the Lord” without blasphemy.

But I knew I needed to write, and I knew the content. I knew it was God that wanted to speak. And I know the Scriptures that allow for Prophets to prophesy in the Church.

As all these thoughts went through my mind, I felt a sudden dread come over me. A deep respect beyond what I had ever known before. This was not evil, but profound and almost overpowering. To put words to my feelings at the time, they might go something like this:

“How dare I presume to write anything that might rise to the level of Scriptural authority”. Or; “How would this be received by the Church?”

At the same time I was reminded of everything that had preceded in my life that might be considered prophetic, especially what our Father told me about our Sister (CS1) and her release from prison according to God’s timetable, rather than man’s.

I brought all these things to the Lord immediately and found comfort in His presence. After that I proceeded to write.

But what really brought a subtle peace was remembering the license plate I had seen when I was on my way to work, and by which I knew the Lord had provided confirmation of the

Prophetic Word against Satan. This happened within a few days after the Devil had been confined to the tree in the back yard.

By this sign (9 / 477-ZMM) I knew the following:

The Ninth (of October) was God's chosen day.

The Son of Man was in control.

Sabbath Rest from battle would be a direct result from this completed Word.

Archangel Michael and his Soldiers would take care of business on that day.

It was firmly decided in Heaven, and God would not change His mind.

There is one more thing I must mention here. In Letter 224 the Lord gave us His Word against the armies of Satan. This Word is specific to the Pacific Northwest, from Alaska, through British Columbia, and including Washington, Idaho, Oregon and Northern California. Satan's armies are comprised of fallen angels, not demons. Demons are different in that they are the spirits of the Nephilim, the angel/human (and possibly other) hybrids whose spirits cannot be resurrected. These enemies remain to be dealt with by the Church.
