Dear Dan,

The following is a true account.

This happened on 10 June 2014 at 12:08 am.

A few minutes ago I jerked my left arm while emptying a trash can and stressed a muscle in my left shoulder. This produced a lingering, throbbing pain on top of the already lingering, throbbing pain left from overusing my shield of faith.

The thought occurred to me to ask angel Gabriella to touch my shoulder. When she did, I felt God's love flow into my shoulder and relax the muscles. A minute later after I worked a little all the (new) pain was gone.

This happened on 11 June 2014 some hours into my work-shift.

On this day at work my lower spine started to shift at the two vertebrae that pinch a nerve and causes my right leg to burn.

I stopped for a second or two, then, remembering what happened the day before, I inquired of the Lord, and then asked angel Gabriel to touch my spine. He obliged, and nothing happened. The leg pain remained until after I got home from work, went to bed, and woke up the next day. Of course the Lord immediately began to instruct us on the purpose of this object lesson. He informed us that in my walk with the Lord He will create a Testimony custom fit to His Purpose of Reconciliation between what I am beginning to call "the Scripture People" and "the Power People". I am writing this just after reading a website that says that if God doesn't heal, it's not His fault. And they cite Jesus as healing all who came to Him. Here is a quote;

"Is it Always God's will to heal someone?"

How can God choose not to heal someone when He already purchased their healing? Was His blood enough for all sin, or just certain sins? Were the stripes He bore only for certain illnesses, or certain seasons of time? When He bore stripes in His body He made a payment for our miracle. He already decided to heal. You can't decide not to buy something after you've already bought it."

After I read that I remembered that Paul came to Jesus three times asking for healing. Here is what Paul wrote;

"Concerning this thing I pleaded with the Lord three times that it might depart from me. And

*He said to me, " My grace is sufficient for you, for My strength is made perfect in weakness." **Therefore most gladly I will rather boast in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me.** Therefore I take pleasure in infirmities, in reproaches, in needs, in persecutions, in distresses, for Christ's sake. **For when I am weak, then I am strong.**"* (2 Corinthians 12:8-10).*

I was reading this website as part on my ongoing investigation concerning Blake Healy's book *The Veil*, and the associated vision the Lord gave to me referenced in Letter 210.

One of the generalities I have observed is the clear division that exists in the American Church concerning this matter. It seems to track a lot on the same lines as the Calvin/ Arminian split that emerged in the European Church centuries ago.

The Calvinists emphasize God's Sovereignty, while the Arminians emphasize Man's Free Choice. What gets me is that in God's first instruction set to Adam, BOTH are clearly seen to be true. In Genesis 2:16 the Lord God COMMANDS the man to be FREE.

In this statement, the Lord God cannot be seen to be any more SOVEREIGN than He is, and Man cannot be seen to be any more FREE than he was.

My question is; why do we Christians argue about it? I think I know why. It seems **likely to be true** that the division is caused by the planting of tares in the wheat field. The Tares act as conduits for the Hellish twins of IGNORANCE and APATHY, Uday and Qusay.

And it is against these Two Satanic Angels that we now fight.
