The National Football Conference (NFC) champion Philadelphia Eagles defeated the defending Super Bowl champion and American Football Conference (AFC) champion New England Patriots, 41–33, to win their first Super Bowl. Eagles quarterback Nick Foles, who completed 28-of-43 pass attempts for 373 yards and three touchdowns with one interception, and caught a 1-yard touchdown pass, was named Super Bowl MVP. Several records were set during the game, including most yards gained in an NFL game by both teams combined: 1,151. The game was held on Sunday, February 4, 2018, at U.S. Bank Stadium in Minneapolis, Minnesota, United States. It was the second Super Bowl in Minneapolis, which hosted Super Bowl XXVI in 1992. It was the sixth Super Bowl in a cold-weather city, and marked a return to the northernmost city to ever host the event.
