DREAM
Broken Connection

Dear Jesus,

Saturday, 11 August 2018, 8PM.

Today after I went to sleep, I had a dream which woke me up at about 1:30PM. As I lay waking up, I discovered that my shoulders were exceedingly sore, and I was tired from exerting much effort. This was because just before I woke up...:

I DREAMED THAT:

I was in my front yard with a gas powered weed-eater. I was pulling on the rip-cord to start the motor. It wouldn't start, but I kept pulling anyway because I wanted to trim my yard of weeds and overgrowth.

My arms began to get really tired from pulling and pulling on the start-cord. But just before I woke up, I was shown a broken electrical wire, causing a disconnection in the motor's electrical circuit, which is why the weed trimmer wouldn't start.

END OF DREAM.

I was able to go back to sleep, and then later on I woke up at my usual time of 5:30PM. But after about 70 minutes of trying to wake up, I found myself getting more and more sleepy, to the point that I had to lay back down in bed.

As I lay in bed, the Lord Holy Spirit then sent some comfort, so I just rested in bed for about thirty minutes and, after being re-energized, went to my computer, which is where I'm at now.

The Lord then began to reveal to me that it was a work of witchcraft which caused the broken wire. But I kept expecting the weed-eater to start normally, so I began to "beat the air" (see 1-Corinthians 9:24-27) by continuing to pull the cord.

Instead, after the first two or three unsuccessful pulls of the cord, I should have inquired of the Lord as to why the motor wouldn't start. He then would have shown me the broken connection right away, and I wouldn't have worn myself out trying to start the motor, and getting so tired from exerting meaningless effort.

I pray that I and others learn this easy lesson so that future conflicts with witchcraft will also be made easy.
