

**Genesis 1:3-5**

Then God said, "Let there be **light**"; and there was **light**. And God saw the **light**, that it was good; and God divided the **light** from the darkness. God called the **light** Day, and the darkness He called Night. So the evening and the morning were the first day.

**Genesis 1:14-16**

Then God said, "Let there be **lights** in the firmament of the heavens to divide the day from the night; and let them be for signs and seasons, and for days and years; and let them be for **lights** in the firmament of the heavens to give **light** on the earth"; and it was so. Then God made two great **lights**: the greater **light** to rule the day, and the lesser **light** to rule the night. He made the stars also.

**Genesis 1:17-18**

God set them in the firmament of the heavens to give **light** on the earth, and to rule over the day and over the night, and to divide the **light** from the darkness. And God saw that it was good.

**Exodus 12:22-23**

So Moses stretched out his hand toward heaven, and there was thick darkness in all the land of Egypt three days. They did not see one another; nor did anyone rise from his place for three days. But all the children of Israel had **light** in their dwellings.

**Exodus 13:21**

And the LORD went before them by day in a pillar of cloud to lead the way, and by night in a pillar of fire to give them **light**, so as to go by day and night.

**Exodus 14:19-20**

And the Angel of God, who went before the camp of Israel, moved and went behind them; and the pillar of cloud went from before them and stood behind them. So it came between the camp of the Egyptians and the camp of Israel. Thus it was a cloud and darkness to the one, and it gave **light** by night to the other, so that the one did not come near the other all that night.

**2 Samuel 23:2-4**

“The Spirit of the LORD spoke by me,  
 And His word was on my tongue.  
 The God of Israel said,  
 The Rock of Israel spoke to me:  
 ‘He who rules over men must be just,  
 Ruling in the fear of God.  
 And he shall be like the **light of the morning**  
 when the sun rises,  
 A morning without clouds,  
 Like the tender grass springing out of the  
 earth, By clear shining after rain.’

**Matthew 5:14-16**

“You are the **light** of the world. A city that is set on a hill cannot be hidden. Nor do they **light** a lamp and put it under a basket, but on a lampstand, and it gives **light** to all who are in the house. Let your **light** so shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven.

**Matthew 10:27**

“Whatever I tell you in the dark, speak in the **light**; and what you hear in the ear, preach on the housetops.

**John 12:35-36**

Then Jesus said to them, “A little while longer the **light** is with you. Walk while you have the **light**, lest darkness overtake you; he who walks in darkness does not know where he is going. While you have the **light**, believe in the **light**, that you may become sons of **light**.”  
 These things Jesus spoke, and departed, and was hidden from them.

**Psalms 27:1**

A Psalm of David.  
 The LORD is my **light** and my salvation;  
 Whom shall I fear?  
 The LORD is the strength of my life;  
 Of whom shall I be afraid?

**Matthew 4:15-16**

“The land of Zebulun and the land of Naphtali,  
 By the way of the sea, beyond the Jordan,  
 Galilee of the Gentiles: The people who sat in  
 darkness have seen a great **light**,  
 And upon those who sat in the region and  
 shadow of death **Light** has dawned.”

**Matthew 6:22-23**

“The lamp of the body is the eye. If therefore your eye is good, your whole body will be full of **light**. But if your eye is bad, your whole body will be full of darkness. If therefore the **light** that is in you is darkness, how great is that darkness!

**Luke 16:8**

So the master commended the unjust steward because he had dealt shrewdly. For the sons of this world are more shrewd in their generation than the sons of **light**.

**1 Thessalonians 5:5**

You are all sons of **light** and sons of the day.  
 We are not of the night nor of darkness.

**Mark 4:21-22**

Also He said to them, "Is a lamp brought to be put under a basket or under a bed? Is it not to be set on a lampstand? For there is nothing hidden which will not be revealed, nor has anything been kept secret but that it should come to **light**."

**Mark 13:24**

"But in those days, after that tribulation, the sun will be darkened, and the moon will not give its **light**;

**Luke 1:79**

To give **light** to those who sit in darkness and the shadow of death,  
To guide our feet into the way of peace."

**Luke 2:32**

A **light** to bring revelation to the Gentiles,  
And the glory of Your people Israel."

**Luke 11:33-36**

"No one, when he has lit a lamp, puts it in a secret place or under a basket, but on a lampstand, that those who come in may see the **light**. The lamp of the body is the eye. Therefore, when your eye is good, your whole body also is full of **light**. But when your eye is bad, your body also is full of darkness. Therefore take heed that the **light** which is in you is not darkness. If then your whole body is full of **light**, having no part dark, the whole body will be full of **light**, as when the bright shining of a lamp gives you **light**."

**Luke 12:3**

Therefore whatever you have spoken in the dark will be heard in the **light**, and what you have spoken in the ear in inner rooms will be proclaimed on the housetops.

**John 1:6-9**

There was a man sent from God, whose name was John. This man came for a witness, to bear witness of the **Light**, that all through him might believe. He was not that **Light**, but was sent to bear witness of that **Light**. That was the true **Light** which gives **light** to every man coming into the world.

**John 3:19-20**

And this is the condemnation, that the **light** has come into the world, and men loved darkness rather than **light**, because their deeds were evil. For everyone practicing evil hates the **light** and does not come to the **light**, lest his deeds should be exposed.

**John 3:21**

But he who does the truth comes to the **light**, that his deeds may be clearly seen, that they have been done in God."

**John 5:35**

He was the burning and shining lamp, and you were willing for a time to rejoice in his **light**.

**John 9:5**

As long as I am in the world, I am the light of the world."

**John 12:35**

Then Jesus said to them, "A little while longer the **light** is with you. Walk while you have the **light**, lest darkness overtake you; he who walks in darkness does not know where he is going. While you have the **light**, believe in the **light**, that you may become sons of **light**." These things Jesus spoke, and departed, and was hidden from them.

**Acts 9:3-4**

As he journeyed he came near Damascus, and suddenly a **light** shone around him from heaven. Then he fell to the ground, and heard a voice saying to him, "Saul, Saul, why are you persecuting Me?"

**Acts 13:47**

For so the Lord has commanded us: I have set you as a **light** to the Gentiles, That you should be for salvation to the ends of the earth.' "

**John 8:12**

Then Jesus spoke to them again, saying, "I am the **light** of the world. He who follows Me shall not walk in darkness, but have the light of life."

**John 11:9-10**

Jesus answered, "Are there not twelve hours in the day? If anyone walks in the day, he does not stumble, because he sees the **light** of this world. But if one walks in the night, he stumbles, because the **light** is not in him."

**John 12:46**

I have come as a light into the world, that whoever believes in Me should not abide in darkness.

**Acts 12:7**

Now behold, an angel of the Lord stood by him, and a **light** shone in the prison; and he struck Peter on the side and raised him up, saying, "Arise quickly!" And his chains fell off his hands.

**Acts 22:6-8**

"Now it happened, as I journeyed and came near Damascus at about noon, suddenly a great **light** from heaven shone around me. And I fell to the ground and heard a voice saying to me, 'Saul, Saul, why are you persecuting Me?' So I answered, 'Who are You, Lord?' And He said to me, 'I am Jesus of Nazareth, whom you are persecuting.'

**Acts 22:9**

“And those who were with me indeed saw the **light** and were afraid, but they did not hear the voice of Him who spoke to me.

**Acts 22:11**

And since I could not see for the glory of that **light**, being led by the hand of those who were with me, I came into Damascus.

**Acts 26:13**

at midday, O king, along the road I saw a **light** from heaven, brighter than the sun, shining around me and those who journeyed with me.

**Acts 26:16-18**

But rise and stand on your feet; for I have appeared to you for this purpose, to make you a minister and a witness both of the things which you have seen and of the things which I will yet reveal to you. I will deliver you from the Jewish people, as well as from the Gentiles, to whom I now send you, to open their eyes, in order to turn them from darkness to **light**, and from the power of Satan to God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins and an inheritance among those who are sanctified by faith in Me.’

**Acts 26:22-23**

Therefore, having obtained help from God, to this day I stand, witnessing both to small and great, saying no other things than those which the prophets and Moses said would come—that the Christ would suffer, that He would be the first to rise from the dead, and would proclaim **light** to the Jewish people and to the Gentiles.”

**Romans 2:17-24**

Indeed you are called a Jew, and rest on the law, and make your boast in God, and know His will, and approve the things that are excellent, being instructed out of the law, and are confident that you yourself are a guide to the blind, a **light** to those who are in darkness, an instructor of the foolish, a teacher of babes, having the form of knowledge and truth in the law.

You, therefore, who teach another, do you not teach yourself? You who preach that a man should not steal, do you steal? You who say, “Do not commit adultery;” do you commit adultery? You who abhor idols, do you rob temples? You who make your boast in the law, do you dishonor God through breaking the law? For “the name of God is blasphemed among the Gentiles because of you,” as it is written.

**1 Corinthians 4:5**

Therefore judge nothing before the time, until the Lord comes, who will both bring to **light** the hidden things of darkness and reveal the counsels of the hearts. Then each one's praise will come from God.

**2 Corinthians 4:5-6**

For we do not preach ourselves, but Christ Jesus the Lord, and ourselves your bondservants for Jesus' sake. For it is the God who commanded **light** to shine out of darkness, who has shone in our hearts to give the **light** of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ.

**2 Corinthians 6:14**

Do not be unequally yoked together with unbelievers. For what fellowship has righteousness with lawlessness? And what communion has **light** with darkness?

**Ephesians 5:8-10**

For you were once darkness, but now you are **light** in the Lord. Walk as children of **light** (for the fruit of the Spirit is in all goodness, righteousness, and truth), finding out what is acceptable to the Lord.

**Colossians 1:12**

... giving thanks to the Father who has qualified us to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in the **light**.

**2 Corinthians 4:1-4**

Therefore, since we have this ministry, as we have received mercy, we do not lose heart. But we have renounced the hidden things of shame, not walking in craftiness nor handling the word of God deceitfully, but by manifestation of the truth commending ourselves to every man's conscience in the sight of God. But even if our gospel is veiled, it is veiled to those who are perishing, whose minds the god of this age has blinded, who do not believe, lest the **light** of the gospel of the glory of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine on them.

**2 Corinthians 11:14**

And no wonder! For Satan himself transforms himself into an angel of **light**. Therefore it is no great thing if his ministers also transform themselves into ministers of righteousness, whose end will be according to their works.

**Ephesians 5:13-14**

But all things that are exposed are made manifest by the **light**, for whatever makes manifest is light. Therefore He says:  
 "Awake, you who sleep,  
 Arise from the dead,  
 And Christ will give you **light**."

**1 Thessalonians 5:5**

You are all sons of **light** and sons of the day. We are not of the night nor of darkness.

**1 Timothy 6:16**

... who alone has immortality, dwelling in **unapproachable light**, whom no man has seen or can see, to whom be honor and everlasting power. Amen.

**2 Timothy 1:10**

... but has now been revealed by the appearing of our Savior Jesus Christ, who has abolished death and brought life and immortality to **light** through the gospel, ...

**1 Peter 2:9**

But you are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, His own special people, that you may proclaim the praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His marvelous **light**;

**2 Peter 1:19**

And so we have the prophetic word confirmed, which you do well to heed as a **light** that shines in a dark place, until the day dawns and the morning star rises in your hearts;

**1 John 1:5-7**

This is the message which we have heard from Him and declare to you, that God is **light** and in Him is no darkness at all. If we say that we have fellowship with Him, and walk in darkness, we lie and do not practice the truth. But if we walk in the **light** as He is in the **light**, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanses us from all sin.

**1 John 2:8-10**

Again, a new commandment I write to you, which thing is true in Him and in you, because the darkness is passing away, and the **true light** is already shining. He who says he is in the **light**, and hates his brother, is in darkness until now. He who loves his brother abides in the **light**, and there is no cause for stumbling in him.

**Revelation 18:23**

The **light** of a lamp shall not shine in you anymore, and the voice of bridegroom and bride shall not be heard in you anymore. For your merchants were the great men of the earth, for by your sorcery all the nations were deceived.

**Revelation 21:10-11**

And he carried me away in the Spirit to a great and high mountain, and showed me the great city, the holy Jerusalem, descending out of heaven from God, having the glory of God. Her **light** was like a most precious stone, like a jasper stone, clear as crystal.

**Revelation 21:23**

The city had no need of the sun or of the moon to shine in it, for the glory of God illuminated it. The Lamb is its **light**.

**Revelation 21:24**

And the nations of those who are saved shall walk in its **light**, and the kings of the earth bring their glory and honor into it.

**Revelation 22:5**

There shall be no night there: They need no lamp nor **light of the sun**, for the Lord God gives them **light**. And they shall reign forever and ever.
